



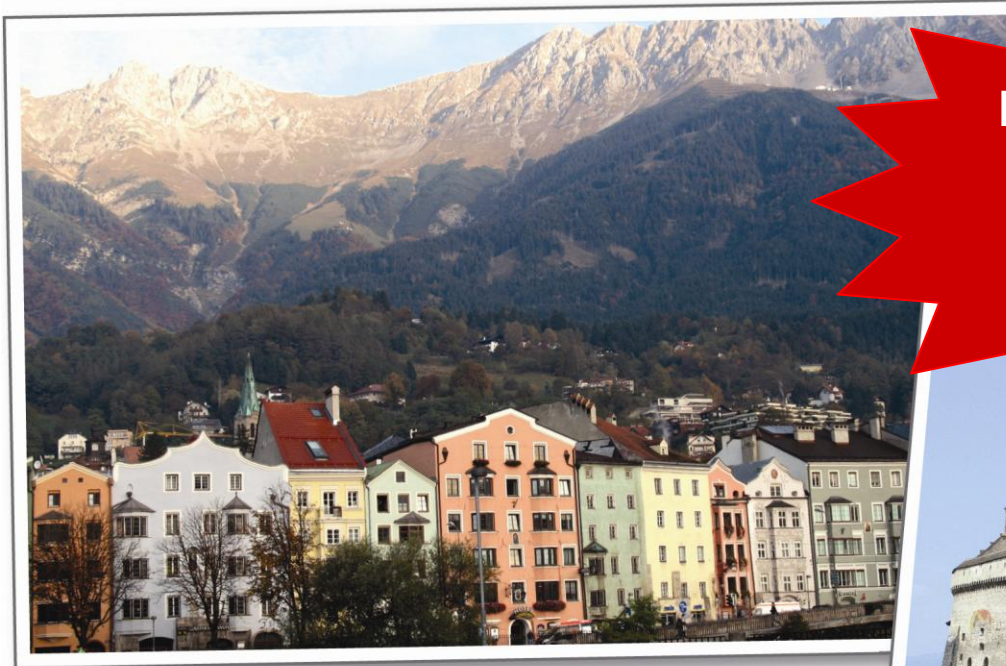

Day 1: Wednesday, September 19, 2012 Overnight Flight

Discover spectacular Switzerland, Austria and Bavaria on a tour featuring four-night stays in two cities. The medieval city of Bern, one of Europe's loveliest capitals, is your host city as you explore the countryside of Switzerland. Next, relax during an extended stay in Innsbruck offering the perfect location from which to explore the delights of Austria and Bavaria.

Day 2: Thursday, September 20, 2012 Bern, Switzerland - Tour Begins

Your tour begins in the capital of Switzerland, Bern, a UNESCO World Heritage site nestled in the Swiss countryside. The cobbled Old Town section is so well preserved that residents who lived here 500 years ago would still find it familiar today. This evening, join your fellow travelers for a welcome dinner featuring local cuisine such as traditional cheese fondue. *Today dinner will be included.*

Day 3: Friday, September 21, 2012 Bern

Explore delightful Bern on a panoramic sightseeing tour featuring the **Bundeshaus (the Swiss Parliament), the famous Bear Pit, the Rose Gardens, and the gothic cathedral, which dominates the Old Town skyline.** Your visit to the Bear Pit will answer the question as to why bears are so revered in this enchanting city. Along the way, your Tour Manager will introduce you to both the language and culture of the region. The remainder of the day is at leisure to explore charming Bern independently. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Day 4: Saturday, September 22, 2012

Bern - Chateau de Chillon - Montreux - Train Ride

Travel the shores of Lake Geneva to the legendary, medieval Chateau de Chillon, a princely residence facing the lake but an imposing fortress from the mountains. **Later,**

enjoy breathtaking Alpine views with a ride on the **GoldenPass Panoramic Train from Montreux to Gstaad.** Discover the delightful ambiance of this world-famous Alpine ski resort with its numerous traditional wood chalets. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Day 5: Sunday, September 23, 2012

Bern - Lucerne - Bern

Travel to Lucerne, the "Swiss Paradise on the Lake." Enjoy a leisurely-paced Alstadt (Old Town) walking tour, exploring the hidden treasures of the city. Lucerne has more than 800 years of history. Explore such medieval treasures as the covered Chapel Bridge (1833); the famous Water Tower which has served as a prison, watchtower and treasury; the Renaissance-style Town Hall; the baroque Jesuit Church; and the Lion Monument, carved from natural rock to commemorate the heroic Swiss Guard. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

Day 6: Monday, September 24, 2012

Bern - Innsbruck, Austria

En route to Innsbruck you will travel through Liechtenstein, the smallest and richest German-speaking country in the world and the only country to lie entirely within the Alps. **Upon arrival in Innsbruck, the "Capital of the Tyrol," a local guide leads a panoramic city tour highlighting the popular thoroughfare, Maria Theresienstrasse; the Hofburg, now a museum, but once the seat of Habsburg princes; and the "Golden Roof," all set against the imposing backdrop of the lovely Austrian Alps.** *Today breakfast will be included.*

Day 7: Tuesday, September 25, 2012

Innsbruck - Salzburg - Innsbruck

Travel through the picturesque Austrian countryside to Salzburg. Upon arrival, enjoy a leisurely-paced walking tour featuring Mirabell Gardens (seen in the "Sound of Music"); the

quaint Getreidegasse (site of Mozart's birthplace); and many other highlights of this beautiful city. The afternoon is at leisure to explore and enjoy Salzburg's fabulous sights. **The day concludes with a delightful dinner at the 1200-year-old St. Peter's Restaurant, the oldest in Austria and still owned by the Monks.** *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

Day 8: Wednesday, September 26, 2012 Innsbruck

Today is at leisure for you to enjoy this beautiful city. You may choose to stroll through the old town and shop at many of the city's outstanding stores or you may just relax and breathe in the fresh mountain air while enjoying a beverage in the many cafés that dot this charming city. *Today breakfast will be included.*

Day 9: Thursday, September 27, 2012

Innsbruck - Bavaria, Germany - Oberammergau - Innsbruck

Today fairy tales come to life with a picture stop at Bavaria's most famous castle, Neuschwanstein. Next, visit Wies Church, proclaimed a World Heritage site, before proceeding to Oberammergau. Enjoy a brief orientation tour of this picturesque village which is famous for the internationally-known Passion Play, performed only every ten years to fulfill a pledge made by the villagers to God for sparing their city from the ravages of bubonic plague in 1633. Later, experience the rich musical tradition of mountainous Austria during a Tyrolean folklore show. Afterwards you are treated to a farewell dinner in one of Innsbruck's most famous traditional restaurants. *Today breakfast and dinner will be included.*

Day 10: Friday, September 28, 2012

Innsbruck - Tour Ends

Your tour ends in Innsbruck. *Today breakfast will be included.*

IMPORTANT RESERVATION INFORMATION

PROOF OF CITIZENSHIP: PASSPORTS AND VISAS

Documentation is required by foreign governments for all trips outside Canada. Clients/passengers should check with the appropriate foreign consulate/embassy for entry requirements, including whether you need to obtain a visa before entering your destination country and, if you do need to get a visa, its cost and timing. Please remember that the possession of valid passports and necessary visas are the responsibility of each client/passenger. If you would like assistance in ensuring you have the proper visa(s) for your trip outside of Canada, we would be happy to refer you to a company that can assist you.

We strongly recommend that you have a valid passport (with six-month validity) for all travel outside Canada.

Passports are required for all Canadians entering the United States.

IDENTIFICATION

Government issued photo identification is required for flying.

When travelling outside Canada, health insurance is required. Contact your booking agent for more details.

TRAVEL CONDITIONS

There may be different living standards and practices and different standards and conditions with respect to the provision of services and accommodations outside of Canada.
